The prestigious James Douglas Medallion has been awarded each year since 1948. It recognises outstanding recently qualified tradespersons who have demonstrated hard work, commitment and determination to achieve industry success. Apprentices are the lifeblood of our industry and it is important we are able to attract and retain the best people entering the workforce.

A top recently qualified tradesperson will be selected from each of the three trades of plumbing, gasfitting, and drainlaying. A finalist may only represent one trade even where they hold two or more trade licences although they may enter more than one category. The overall James Douglas Medallion recipient will be chosen from these three finalists, and will receive a \$500 cash prize together with a Career Development Scholarship to the value of \$2,500 from Skills. This is a major prize designed to build the winner's career progression.

Criteria

- Nominations may be made by Master Plumbers members, by non-members, and by Regional Managers
- The nominee's employer does not need to be a current Master Plumbers member
- Nominees must have gained or be close to achieving their National Certificate qualifications in Plumbing, Gasfitting and/or Drainlaying, and have also passed their registration exams
- Applicants must provide evidence of registration exam result.
